

ANTIFUNGAL DECISION MAKING

*DRUGS OF CHOICE FOR ORAL FUNGAL INFECTIONS**

The first drugs of choice for local treatment of oral fungal infections are:

Mycelex Troche or Nystatin Tablets

The drug of choice for systematic treatment of oral fungal infections is:

Diflucan

The drug of choice for angular cheilitis is:

Nystatin/Triamcinolone (Formerly Mycolog II) Cream
(Rx on page 52)

NOTE: Chlorhexidine (Rx on page 60) has been shown to be of value to control oral fungal infections, especially in HIV-infected patients. (Symptomatic patients rinse 2 times per day; asymptomatic patients rinse 1 time per day at night.)
